2021 WESTBROOK MUSTER RULES & INFO

CAMPING AND TARPS/CANOPIES:

- +Regular camping and set up opens Friday, August 27, at 9:00am.
- +Early Camping and set up will be offered Thursday, August 26, from 5:00pm to 9:00pm for a donation of
- \$10 per tent/camper. Tarps/canopies around the muster field may also be set up at this time at no charge.
- +No admittance prior to 5:00pm Thursday or from 9:00pm Thursday to 9:00am Friday.
- +No cars may be parked in the camping area, even if you plan on sleeping in it. You may unload then move to a designated parking area.
- +Camping is limited to muster participants and their families only. No open flames, holes, or dogs permitted.
- +The muster field and camping area must be completely cleared by 12:00pm Sunday, August 29.

GENERATORS:

Generators may not be run/operated during hours of curfew, 11:00pm to 8:00am.

Make necessary arrangements to handle medical needs so that generators are not necessary, or consider staying in a local state park, campground, or hotel.

PERFORMANCE INFO:

The muster field entry will be reversed this year. We must limit on-stand performances to 8 minutes!

In attempting to reduce the close proximity of participants, we are reversing the muster field entry and exit this year. Corps will now enter between first base and home plate, and exit the field at second base. Corps are also encouraged to perform towards corps tents. Due to feedback that we have received from corps, we must limit performances to 8 minutes, including marching on and off. Failure to comply may result in revoked invitation next year.

CURFEW:

Curfew has been extended to 11:00pm on the muster field Friday and Saturday.

No Fifing, drumming, music, loud conversations, etc. after this time. Please respect the curfew, fellow campers, and our Westbrook neighbors.

ALCOHOL:

Alcoholic beverages are permitted in the fenced camping and muster field areas only.

It is a town ordinance and strictly enforced. The legal drinking age in CT is 21. It is against the law to supply anyone under age 21 with alcohol and persons doing so are subject to arrest.

REGISTRATION:

Registration will be at the announcers table from 9:00am to 10:00 am on Saturday.

If you miss this opportunity, it will open again once the muster has started.

MUSTER LINE UP:

The muster line up will be announced on our Facebook page and Website on Friday, August 27 at 9:00am. If a corps decides not to perform on stand, the next corps will take its place, no substitutions (unless special circumstances). The line up will also be featured in our Muster Program and around the muster field/parade areas.

MUSTER MEAL:

Due to COVID-19 we are unable to safely serve a muster meal this year.

Food will be available for purchase from the Boy Scouts Tent Friday & Saturday.

40+ YEARS CORPS:

This year, the 40+ years corps will occur after the Westbrook Jr. Colonials on-stand performance and before Moodus Drum & Fife Corps. Line up in the shoot while the Westbrook Jr. Colonials are performing. Those with 40+ years of fife & drum experience are invited to come on stand to play 'Road to Boston.'

By attending the Westbrook Muster, you acknowledge the potential risk of contracting COVID-19. We ask you to follow current CDC guidelines while attending the event. Masks are strongly encouraged while in close proximity to others.
